Our service area has approximately 73 miles of sanitary sewer lines, 3,073 manholes and 3 lift stations within its sanitary sewer system. While sanitary sewer system problems are not common, ChelWater and Waste Water is instituting a Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Program, which is intended to avoid or minimize problems to the maximum extent possible. The first phase of cleaning will begin in mid-September 2018 and will run through the end of the year.
