

Reagan Station / Chelsea County Power and Light



South Potomac and South Jordan Road.

A new Reagan Station, completed in 2015 is a state of the art Power Generation and Transfer Station owner by Chelsea County Power and Light. To include 4 substations this location is the primary source for electrical generation, transmission, and distribution for all of Chelsea County USA. The 4 substations transform voltage from high to low, or the reverse, or perform any of several other important functions. Between the generating station and consumer, electric power may flow through several substations at different voltage levels. This new station serves approximately 1 million customers in unincorporated Chelsea County, Tyler Town, Blakeville and Cole City.

The primary station and substations are owned and operated by the electrical utility. The main station is manned however the substations are unattended, relying on SCADA for remote supervision and control.
